Habitat for Humanity Philippines is appealing for your assistance in helping the families affected by Typhoon Sendong (Washi), particularly in Cagayan de Oro City and Iligan City, which were the worst hit areas with over 60,000 families affected, 10,000 of which lost their homes.

As part of its rehabilitation program, Habitat needs to raise funds for at least 5,000 Emergency Shelter Repair Kits. Each shelter repair kit costs P5,000 consisting of materials, tools and cleaning items that will help a family immediately rebuild their home. A social investment of P2,000,000, for example, will help 400 Filipino families. Habitat can mobilize the distribution of the repair kits within one week upon receipt of the donation.
